






Coverage with Oral PrEP












Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) Service Delivery

Milestones CAB-LA Implementation



'Ukraine has become one of the five PEPFAR partner countries prioritized for scaling up access to CAB-LA as PrEP.' 2024

CAB-LA registered in Ukraine and will be included in the standards of medical care

An online questionnaire has been launched to form a list of interested clients in obtaining CAB-LA A press briefing on the implementation of CAB-LA in Ukraine was held



Ukraine received long-acting cabotegravir in the amount of 1350 vials

The information campaign on the introduction of CAB-LA as PrEP in Ukraine continues

Syringes, injection needles and HIV antigen/antibody tests were purchased

A Working Group on the organization of the introduction of injectable drugs for the prevention of HIV infection has been created

The Roadmap for the introduction of long-acting cabotegravir (CAB-LA) as a PrEP in Ukraine was created and approved

A two-day training on the implementation of CAB-LA in Ukraine was held on September 12-13, 2023

> An information campaign about CAB-LA has started

The protocol for the introduction of longacting cabotegravir (CAB-LA) in Ukraine was developed and agreed (inclusion criteria, contraindications, clinical and laboratory monitoring, injection schedule)

A communication framework for CAB-LA implementation in Ukraine has been developed

Negotiations were held with representatives of health care facilities in Lviv and Kyiv, consent was obtained to participate in the implementation of CAB-LA

Implementation challenges

- □ War (shelling, displaced persons, uncertain conditions, damaged infrastructure, logistics challenges)
- Military conscription of medical staff and clients
- □ Lack of awareness among key populations







Recommendations for implementation

1 Coordination and Collaboration

Foster partnerships among NGOs, international organizations, and government agencies. Conduct regular assessments to refine approaches and enhance service quality.

2 Institutionalization of Changes

Secure official registration of medications and incorporate them into national standards. Approve testing protocols to ensure the reliability and sustainability of changes.

3 Demand creation

Develop outreach strategies that focus on respected community leaders. Engage local leaders to foster trust and acceptance of programs among target audiences.

Training for Personnel

Organize comprehensive training sessions for healthcare and social workers. Cover counseling, testing, prescribing, and managing medications to enhance service quality. **5** Logistics and Supplies

Establish efficient supply chains to ensure uninterrupted service delivery. Guarantee a steady supply of materials such as needles, syringes, and testing kits.
